COYOTE CREEK OUTDOORS, LLC PRIMARY FIREARMS SAFETY RULES

The range at Coyote Creek Outdoors, LLC is a COLD range. That is, all firearms not on the firing line are to be unloaded and cased. The exception to this are people who possess a MN Permit to Carry may carry their firearm loaded as long as it remains holstered. If using their carry gun on the range they may only unholster the gun at the firing line only.

Handling of firearms behind the firing line will result in the immediate expulsion of the shooter and/or his/her party without refund.

Range Usage

Coyote Creek Outdoors, LLC follows all Federal, State and Local laws regarding the possession and use of firearms. To this end we welcome all shooters age 21 and older who are not prohibited by law from owning or possessing a firearm. Shooters 18 and over are eligible to shoot rifles without restriction. Shooters 10-21 may shoot under supervision of parents, guardians and adults who have signed documentation of parental consent. 18-21 must still have a signed guardian to shoot pistol or our machine guns.

Core Safety Rules

- 1. Treat every firearm as if it is loaded.
- 2. Always keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction.
- 3. Keep your finger off the trigger until your sights are on the target.
- 4. Be sure of your target and what is behind it.
- 5. When a **CEASE FIRE** command is **given by anyone** on the range,

STOP SHOOTING IMMEDIATELY and await commands from the Range Officer.

LLC - GUN RANGE RULES

All gun range users are required to read, understand, and comply with all Primary Firearm Safety Rules and Gun Range Rules before proceeding to any ranges. If you have questions, please ask any Range Safety Officer for clarification.

- 1. No Member or nonmember will be allowed to use the gun range without a Range Officer on duty and in the gun range facility.
- 2. If you observe an unsafe condition, immediately report it to the Range Officer.
- 3. Being under the influence of alcohol or drugs on the range is prohibited.
- 4. No child under the age of 10 may enter the gun range area.
- 5. Eye and ear protection are mandatory for each person before entering the range and must be worn at all times while on the range.
- 6. Wear appropriate clothing. Tank tops, low cut tops, flip-flops, and open toe footwear are not allowed. Wearing a brimmed cap is recommended. **HOT BRASS CAN BE UNCOMFORTABLE!**
- 7. Coyote Creek Outdoors, LLC strongly recommends that pregnant women not enter in the shooting range. Scientific studies have concluded that fetal exposure to loud noises and lead may cause harm to the child.
- 8. No more than two firearms uncased at the firing line. When finished with a firearm, properly case the unloaded firearm and ammunition before uncasing the next firearm.
- 9. Keep the action open and the firearm unloaded until ready to shoot.
- 10. All unholstered firearms must be unloaded and cased when being taken to or removed from your lane. Moving a firearm from one lane to another requires it to be cased and unloaded.
- 11. Fire only from within your booth. All other persons are to be behind the firing line.
- 12. Transferring a firearm from one shooter to another will be accomplished by placing the unloaded weapon with the action open on the shooting bench.
- 13. Ammunition and or feeding devices, i.e. magazines, clips and speed loaders are to be handled at the shooting bench.

- 14. Use only targets approved by Coyote Creek Outdoors, LLC and properly attached to the backer. Shooting of the target clip will cost you one dollar.
- 15. Shooters may collect their brass only; if it is behind the firing line.
- 16. Be certain that your firearms are safe to operate; if unsure, have a qualified gunsmith check the firearm before use.
- 17. Use only correct and safe ammunition in your firearms.
- 18. The use of steel case, aluminum case, steel core armor piercing, tracer, incendiary or bi-metal jacket is not permitted in the range. All ammunition will be tested magnetically, no magnetically reactive will be allowed in the range.
- 19. Food, drink, gum, and smoking are not permitted in gun range area.
- 20. Wash your hands with soap and cold water each time you leave the range.
- 21. It is strictly prohibited to draw from a holster, use a sling of any kind, to remove a counter or gate at any time for any reason, or be ahead of the benches unless accompanied by a Coyote Creek Outdoors, LLC Gun Range employee, for an event, or otherwise instructed.
- 22. Shots that strike any surface other than the designated paper target (e.g., ceiling, floor, target carrier, track, etc.) will result in the Range Officer asking the shooter to leave for the day. No headshots or shots near the top of the target are allowed unless the target is hung lower on the backer.
- 23. All patrons of Coyote Creek Outdoors, LLC are financially responsible for any damage or destruction they have caused to gun range property, whether accidental, negligent, willful or otherwise. This may include attorney fees.
- 24. Coyote Creek Outdoors, LLC Gun Range reserves the right to reject or refuse anyone access to all facilities.
- 25. Coyote Creek Outdoors, LLC is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged property.
- 26. Suicide prevention, as a public range Coyote Creek Outdoors, LLC is at risk of individuals renting guns in an effort to end their own lives. Should this occur, Coyote Creek Outdoors, LLC will initiate legal action against their estate to recoup losses and damages.

MEMBERSHIP AND GUN RENTAL RULES

- 1. Purchase of a Coyote Creek Outdoors, LLC Range Membership, requires a current driver's license, passport, or similar documentation to confirm identity.
- 2. Nonmembers are required to present a current driver's license, passport, or similar document prior to range use or access.
- 3. Nonmembers are not allowed to use the gun range or equipment if they are shooting alone and using the Coyote Creek Gun Range for the first time.
- 4. Nonmembers may be allowed to shoot alone if they provide their own firearm(s) and/or have a valid permit to carry, are accompanied by a second person, or are taking a private lesson one on one with an instructor.
- 5. Only ammunition purchased from the Coyote Creek Outdoors, LLC Gun Range may be used in rental firearms.
- 6. Prior to using the range for the first time, all members and nonmembers must view the gun range safety video and read range rules. Annual renewal required.
- 7. Members and Non-members are required to sign a release prior to using the range, renewed annually or when changes have been made to the waiver.

Liability Waiver and Age Restrictions

- All users of the Coyote Creek Outdoors, LLC range must fill out and sign a liability waiver before using the range, and as deemed appropriate by Coyote Creek management. Members and Nonmembers must have a current and signed liability waiver on file before using the range.
- 2. Special events may require an event waiver that is only valid for the day of the event.
- 3. No child under the age of 10 may enter the gun range area.
- 4. Youth ages 10 to 17 must have a signed guardian present to shoot any firearm. People ages 18 to 20 may shoot long guns but must have someone over 21 sign and be present to shoot pistol.
- 5. Youth waivers must be filled out each time a minor comes in to shoot. The person signing as the adult must be present in the range and in supervision of the minor. The person supervising the minor may not be shooting in a separate lane.
- 6. Coyote Creek Outdoors, LLC follows all Federal, State and Local laws regarding the possession and use of firearms. We welcome all shooters age 21 and older who are not prohibited by law from owning or possessing a firearm. Shooters 18 and over are eligible to shoot rifles without restriction. Shooters 10-21 may shoot under supervision of parents, guardians and adults who have signed documentation of parental consent.
